1 (a) EITHER

(i) List and explain **two** changes that have occurred in Hinduism from its inception. [4]

OR

(ii) List **four** of the rites of passage in Traditional Zambian Society. [4]

(b) (i) Narrate a passage from the Gospel of Luke in which Jesus challenged the Hebrew people to change their attitude of hate towards their enemies. [12]

(ii) Using ideas from the above passage, give **four** practical examples of how a Christian today can have an attitude of love toward his/her enemies. [4]

2 (a) EITHER

(i) Explain the aim of work in African Traditional Society and list any **three** important basic needs that were provided. [4]

OR

(ii) Briefly discuss **four** church teachings about the purpose and meaning in one's life. [4]

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(b) (i) Give the content of the passage from Jeremiah in which the prophet showed concern with unjust working conditions. [12]

(ii) Give **four** practical examples of how politicians in Zambia today can help remove unjust conditions at places of work. [4]

3 (a) EITHER

(i) Briefly explain the **four** elements that are involved when Hindus celebrate with great devotion the Festival of cattle. [4]

OR

(ii) Give **two** Biblical attitudes and **two** stoic attitudes towards leisure. [4]

(b) (i) Give the content of the passage from the book of Ecclesiastes that illustrates that leisure time activities have a place in man's life. [4]

(ii) With reference to the passage in (i) above, what advice would you give to a Christian friend who only wants to study the word of God during leisure time. [4]

4 (a) EITHER

- (i) List and explain **four** injustices that exist within the Zambian social system today. [4]

OR

- (ii) State **four** ideas on how harmony brought about justice in African tradition. [4]

- (b) (i) Give the content of the passage from the book of Luke which urges people not to judge others unjustly. [12]

- (ii) Using the ideas from the above passage, suggest **four** ways in which a pastor can guide his/her followers in creating a more just society. [4]

5 (a) EITHER

- (i) State any **four** of the five pillars of Islam. [4]

OR

- (ii) State **four** ideas about leadership and authority in the early church. [4]

- (b) (i) Give content of a bible passage from the book of Colossians in which Paul shows how happy he is to be Christ's servant. [12]

- (ii) Using ideas from the above passage, give **four** practical examples in which a Christian can be of service to his community. [4]

6 (a) EITHER

- (i) Mention the **four** paths or ways from which the Hindu can choose and remain loyal to them. [4]

OR

- (ii) Briefly mention **four** elements that were considered as a source of disloyalty in traditional society. [4]

- (b) (i) Give the content of the passage from the book of Jeremiah which explains that true loyalty to God is in the just treatment of people and not outward observance of laws. [12]

- (ii) Using ideas from the above passage, what advice would you give to a strong church goer, but whose behaviour is contrary to the church teachings. [4]

7 (a) EITHER

(i) Give **four** things that a modern man thinks brings happiness today. [4]

OR

(ii) List **four** ways which helped strengthen harmony and status in African Traditional Society. [4]

(b) (i) Give the content of a Bible passage from the Gospel of John which shows that life is a mixture of joy and sorrow. [12]

(ii) What advice can you give to a pupil who has been going through a lot of suffering using the above passage. [4]

8 (a) EITHER

(i) Discuss **four** attitudes towards death among late adolescents. [4]

OR

(ii) State **four** ideas that explain the Christian concepts of Heaven. [4]

(b) (i) Give the content of the passage from the Book of Isaiah which shows how the Hebrews came to believe that there is life after death. [12]

(ii) Give **four** reasons today why people have hope for life after death. [4]

9 (a) EITHER

(i) Discuss briefly **four** ideas why Alms giving is important to any successful Muslim to perform. [4]

OR

(ii) State **four** ideas on Ecumenism among Christian churches in the world. [4]

(b) (i) Give the content of the passage in Mathews' Gospel which shows how Jesus rejected wealth, power and prestige as a basis of success in favour of doing God's will. [4]

(ii) Using ideas from the above passage, show with **four** examples how a Christian can give advice to someone who says success depends on having riches. [4]

10 (a) EITHER

- (i) Briefly mention **four** factors that have contributed to urban marriages breaking up. [4]

OR

- (ii) Describe **four** aspects that were involved in the education of children in Traditional African Society. [4]

- (b) (i) Give the content of a passage from the book of St. Luke which explains Jesus' attitude that the family is only valuable if it is based on the love of God. [12]
- (ii) Give **four** practical examples why children should be obedient to their parents. [4]

11 (a) EITHER

- (i) Briefly explain any **four** elements that are attached to the importance of women according to the "Laws of Manu".

OR

- (ii) List **four** teachings of the Christian Church on the respective roles of men and women. [4]

- (b) (i) Give the content of the passage from the book of Judges that explains that a woman was chosen by God to liberate the Hebrews from their enemies. [12]
- (ii) Explain in **four** ways the advice you would give to a Christian friend who insists that women are not fit to lead other Christians in praising God. [4]

12 (a) EITHER

- (i) Mention **four** pieces of advice an uncle/father gave a boy before marriage in Traditional Society. [4]

OR

- (ii) Mention **two** things that are essential and **two** things that are not essential in a Christian marriage ceremony. [4]

- (b) (i) Give the content of a passage from 1 Corinthians which teaches mutual trust and self-giving. [12]
- (ii) Explain any **four** problems that may occur in a marriage relationship if there is no trust between the couple. [4]

- (i) Briefly describe what a religious ritual is and mention **three** characteristics of such a ritual. [4]

OR

- (ii) Give **four** ways through which the church today brings people to God. [4]

- (b) (i) Give the content of a passage from Acts of Apostles which explains that non-Jews were also true seekers of God and the Truth about Him. [12]

- (ii) Suggest, with examples, any **four** obstacles which may hinder peoples' search for God in Zambia today. [4]

14 (a) EITHER

- (i) Briefly explain in **two** ways what witchcraft and divination are. [4]

OR

- (ii) Give **two** teachings of Tertullian found in the city of Carthage and the other two teachings of Clement in the city of Alexandria. [4]

- (b) (i) Give the content of a passage from Psalms which explains that self-centredness and pride lead some people to deny God. [12]

- (ii) Show with **four** examples how people can deny the existence of God in Zambia today by their actions. [4]

15 (a) EITHER

- (i) State **four** ideas that explain how Muslims try to involve themselves with God in the improvement of the whole world today. [4]

OR

- (ii) Briefly explain the meaning of Eucharist and show in **three** ways how Christians involve themselves with Christ by celebrating it. [4]

- (b) (i) Narrate the content of a passage from the Gospel of Luke that emphasises that prayer is the source of strength for Christians in doing God's work. [12]

- (ii) Explain with **four** examples how Christians today can be seen doing God's will through prayer. [4]

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
